

University Professor Ralph Mösges, M.D. Ph.D. FAAAAI an otorhinolaryngologist and allergologist, is the chairman of the Institute of Medical Statistics, Informatics and Epidemiology at the University Hospital of the Medical Faculty of the University of Cologne, Germany. His current research fields are allergic and infectious diseases of the upper airways, epidemiology, and clinical pharmacology. Ralph Mösges is the author and editor of ten books and has published more than 200 articles in major journals. He is in the editorial board of the journal Rhinology and several other journals. He is the chairman of ISCOANA a task force of the European Rhinologic Society (ERS) and serves as a member of the guidelines committee of the German Academy of Otorhinolaryngology for the development of guidelines in rhinosinusitis and in sudden deafness. He chairs the ENT-section of the European Academy of Allergy and serves as vice-president on the board of INTERASMA, the global asthma association.
